## **Astrological Midpoints**

### **History of Midpoint Combinations**

What is a Midpoint?

The use of midpoints historically goes back to 1200 AD when Guido Bonati, a famous Italian Astrologer, used half sums, otherwise known as midpoints, in his interpretation of a chart. More recently at the turn of the century, Alan Leo, a famous British Astrologer, used midpoints along with solar arc directions. I personally have no knowledge of the use of midpoints combined with the 90-degree dial prior to its use by Reinhold Ebertin and Alfred Witte at the beginning of the Nineteen Hundreds. The history of solar arcs on the other hand, goes back to Ptolemy who used primary directions in the second century.

A midpoint is the center between any two points, which in Astrology relates to the center between two planets and/or personal points, including the Midheaven, Ascendant, and the Nodes. This center point is the meeting of planetary energies that becomes active through the process of growth, relating to the passage of time. We relate to the aspects formed by the heavenly bodies through spatial relationship. This system as I mentioned earlier goes back to Reinhold Ebertin who, near the turn of the century developed this system along with Alfred Witte by taking a 360-degree wheel and breaking it down into a 90-degree dial. Ebertin believed that hard aspects created events in one's life thus; the use of the 90-degree dial became a viable tool for forecasting future events. Ebertin started by placing the planets into three sections -- 30 degrees for Cardinal Positions which include: Aries, Cancer, Libra and Capricorn points; 30 degrees for Fixed Positions which include: Taurus, Leo, Scorpio and Aquarius points; and 30 degrees for Mutable Positions which include: Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius and Pisces points.

This system can be seen on the 90 degree dial as 0 to 30 degrees as Cardinal, 30 to 60 degrees Fixed and 60 to 90 degrees as Mutable positions for the planetary points to be placed in accordance of their quality.

### **How to Use this System**

This system can be used to add great insight into the interpretations of the natal chart through the use of delineation of transits, progressions, solar arcs and degree arcs. In fact it can be used in almost any interpretive form of astrology where timing is added into the equation. Timing is where this type of Astrology becomes very precise and accurate. The best way to use this system is to incorporate the natal midpoint along with the time that its energy becomes activated by directing the planets into the future. This is done by Solar Arc, which is the distance it takes for the Sun to move from one day to the next at the time of one's birth, which is approximately 59'

to 1 degree 2', which is then added to the age in question. We can also use degree arcs, known as age arcs, which is equivalent to one degree equals one year, times the number of years old you are now and/or when the specific event in question occurred. It may sound difficult, but it's not once you become familiar with this system of delineation. When using this tool you will notice that I have included health interpretations along with dietary issues, which often come up when there is a lack of good nutrition or assimilation of nutrients. This can be seen easily through the activation of the natal midpoints on the 90-degree dial. Thus, I included medical interpretations in most of the midpoint structures.

Each midpoint structure has many meanings, so I have narrowed it down to the most important interpretation of each of them based upon my years of past experience. These interpretations are done in the higher and lower, or shadow manifestations. We are all on the earth plane of existence, thus no matter how enlightened we may seem, we still have to deal with our shadow. Many midpoints include births, health areas and transitions and only a part of what is said may apply to you personally. But on the other hand the whole interpretation may apply. I have included the positive and negative side of each of these midpoints so as to reach all probable outcomes.

Many times there will be others who are read through one's personal chart, since these people become the players in one's personal movie. These players include midpoints with:

Moon	=	Mother and the Feminine principal
Saturn	=	Father/Business Associates, masculine principal
Mercury/Mars	=	Brothers and Male Relatives
Mercury/Venus	=	Sisters and Female Relatives
Sun/Node	=	Children
Venus/Uranus	=	Female Friends
Mars/Uranus	=	Male Friends
Jupiter	=	Grandparents

Relationships include almost any midpoint, which involves the Sun, Moon, Venus and Mars combined with the personal points, Asc, Mc, Moon and Node and always be aware of the rulerships of these positions.

## **Your Birth Chart: Midpoint Combinations**

The natal midpoints represent our birth traits, our strengths, weaknesses and potential for personal growth. Each midpoint could involve others who are part of our life's path. Thus, a natal midpoint may apply to family and friends as opposed to the energy being directed to the self. Likewise, the medical influences and health issues mentioned are often manifest by others in our lives as opposed to the self. The possible medical problems, as well as the "shadow side" of a midpoint may never become an active manifestation of the midpoint's energy when addressed early. Keep an open mind when reading the interpretations of a midpoint since they are geared to both the higher and lower manifestations of the energy, and be aware that medical references should not be treated as a diagnosis. Psychological or physical symptoms or problems should be directed to the appropriate professional for diagnosis and evaluation. The timing of the events indicated by these natal midpoints are activated by progressions, directions and finally transits as the final touch off point sometime in the future.

### **Moon=Jupiter/Neptune**      Natal

This bestows feminine powers of intuition along with perceptual abilities. Many highly successful psychics are influenced by this energy. There is usually a love of water and/or the desire to live on, or near, the water. On the negative, or misuse of this energy, one usually has problems living in this reality and has a sense of other worldliness about them. They may even have problems with assimilation of nutrition; thus a weakened body or immune system becomes the end result. Medically this rules allergies and/or problems with breathing, such as asthma, which may be created through confusion in one's thoughts or beliefs.

### **Sun=Mercury/Saturn**      Natal

The boss or the person who is in a position of authority is a reflection of this energy, as well as having the capacity to lead others professionally. On the shadow side, there can be slow growth of the bones and/or organic developmental problems along with forced growth or maturation. One has the ability to concentrate but on the other side there is difficulty when dealing with depression due to feeling that there is no way out. There can be separations from others that try to dominate and/or one is dominating over them. Always remember events in one's life are simply a reflection of their own inner reality, thus we can change the final outcome through advanced knowledge.

### **Sun=Mercury/Node**      Natal

Connecting with a man who is interesting to talk to and has similar views is a manifestation of this aspect. It rules the intelligent man who could become one's mate. It also denotes people who work in the communications industry. Many times a sibling can

be born at this time.

**Sun=Venus/Uranus** Natal

There can be lots of excitement, happiness, and enjoyment with the friendships one has made now. One has the capacity to express the self in a unique and unusual way to the outer world and there can be sudden or unexpected advancements in life. This relates to falling in love suddenly with a very exciting yet unpredictable person and committing to them immediately.

**Sun=Mars/Ascendant** Natal

One can have physical health and vitality as well as being attracted to men who are healthy and muscular or men who have a pioneering quality about them. This denotes attraction to a man who is vital with a love of life whom one may get engaged to and/or marry. This is one of the best times to connect one to men who are going somewhere and have a lust for life. For either a man and/or a woman this attracts one to what they want and gives a period of success due to the attraction of others.

**Sun=Jupiter/Midheaven** Natal

This is one of the most favorable midpoints in the zodiac, in that it bestows great wealth, fame, and happiness, giving one many opportunities, one after another. Many people who have been born into wealth, and/or seek it, have this in their chart. It's also a time to advance in one's career, and/or reaching the top of the career quickly. It connects one with influential people who include them in their social circle. This also denotes meeting a mate, but in this case one probably won't have to worry about them being financially stable, since they are usually financially set with good careers and want to share it.

**Sun=Uranus/Ascendant** Natal

This is usually a highly intellectual person who needs to walk to the beat of a different drummer. They are gifted in some area of their life, and yet have difficulty working within the system. They're the circle within the square, in that they go opposite from the norm. This can affect one's health by stimulating the circulatory system, making one seem very erratic at times with a volatile personality, where change is the name of the game. Sometimes one will even change their birth name to something they feel is more an expression of who they are, an example might be Falling Leaf expressing someone who carries the energy of fall or October.

**Mercury=Saturn/Midheaven** Natal

Organizational abilities, attention to detail, concentration, and intention are some of the qualities manifested through this energy. All of these qualities are usually used in one's career pursuits. This relates to deep study and needing time alone to plan and/organize for one's future. With the misuse of this energy, there can be problems with people in authority through breakdowns of communications. Medically, this relates to lung problems, low back difficulties with the disks, intestinal blocks and/or breaks in the fingers or hands. This also relates to the father and/or a sibling's health that may encompass the medical areas mentioned above.

**Venus=Ascendant (Beautiful Appearance)** Natal

Venus and the Ascendant combine physical appearance with beauty. This effects the

environment through the creation of a beautiful place with pleasant ambiance. Many interior decorators have this energy since they can combine a sense of artistic beauty with the knowledge of placement. Artists, dancers and singers have this, as do hairdressers, representing a large full head of beautiful luxurious hair which people notice first about you. There can also be the capacity to be a good listener and to hear what someone is saying; thus this represents acute hearing abilities. It denotes the person who walks in beauty with beautiful inviting eyes, presenting a beautiful face to the world. People with this influence have a very pleasant appearance. There is talent for combining colors together with an artistic flair. Many people use this energy to get their hair cut and styled and go on a shopping spree, since this relates to spending money on one's self. On the shadow side, there can be over indulgence in areas of pleasure, thus this relates to the pleasure seeker who wastes time and money. There is also a tendency to party too much, always wanting to feel good and not accomplishing much or using energy incorrectly. This denotes the narcissist.

**Mars=Uranus (Unpredictable Energy) Natal**

The energy of Mars combines with the unexpected quality of Uranus to create events that come from out of the blue or have an unpredictable nature, as in sudden electrical shocks, lightning or hearing shocking news. There's an attraction to the unusual or unique when it comes to friends, for a woman this would be interest in a rebellious type of man. One has the ability to individuate by not following the normal drumbeat and there can be association with unusual groups of people who are interested in advanced sciences or unique studies. There can also be activities done in haste that could potentially cause accidents. There's a love of fast cars, or sports cars, or being a sports car driver since there's a need for lots of excitement and taking chances. Many stunt people have this quality. This also represents male bonding as in working out together at a health club or in any physical activity. A male child who embodies some of the qualities mentioned above can be born into a family.

**Jupiter=Sun/Pluto Natal**

These are the people who carry and form the beliefs from one generation to the next. This relates to the study of occult knowledge and an interest in secret societies. Many priests, Shamans, and people who are dedicated to a belief system have this, as well as people who incorporate sexuality with philosophy to attain their personal goals. It relates to books written which affect the consciousness of the masses. This is great for financial gain through an inheritance or an insurance claim, thus this relates to gaining through the transition of a grandparent. It represents the IRS and dealing with our taxes and/or being audited. This is the height of great personal power, creating financial success, and personal gain that results in extreme wealth. There can also be births and transitions within the family under this.

**Saturn=Mercury/Jupiter Natal**

One can have many worries about "should I expand or should I contract," or there could be financial concerns. There could be a decision to make a major purchase, like a home, along with possible changes in the stock market which could effect one's personal stocks and changes in the interest rates. Many people experience depression due to not making a decision until it's too late, or by just being complacent. This also relates to feeling like

one doesn't have enough in the present moment. Thus, the "not enough" syndrome is part of one's life's journey.

**Saturn=Venus/Neptune** Natal

One may have difficulties in their expression of love, or there can be deceit from a partner on a financial level. This is visually represented by a bridge over troubled waters, and yes, bridge builders have this in their charts. There is also a feeling of having been in love before and having lost that love to another. One may have health issues brought about through unhappiness within a relationship, sobering to the reality that the relationship has changed and may be ending.

**Saturn=Neptune/Ascendant** Natal

Setting personal boundaries is a function of this, due to the limitations created in early life through one's personal environment. There may have been alcoholism or some form of substance abuse which causes one to feel emotionally deprived. This also relates to past life karma which may need to be played out and eliminated in the present. Either way, there is a feeling that one can't get ahead in life; thus, medically, this rules diseases which limit, as in arthritis, bone disease, tooth decay, and sleep disorders. There's also a tendency to define one's spiritual reality, helping one to work within a constructive framework.

**Uranus=Mars (Unpredictable Energy)** Natal

The energy of Mars combines with the unexpected quality of Uranus to create events that come from out of the blue or have an unpredictable nature, as in sudden electrical shocks, lightning or hearing shocking news. There's an attraction to the unusual or unique when it comes to friends, for a woman this would be interest in a rebellious type of man. One has the ability to individuate by not following the normal drumbeat and there can be association with unusual groups of people who are interested in advanced sciences or unique studies. There can also be activities done in haste that could potentially cause accidents. There's a love of fast cars, or sports cars, or being a sports car driver since there's a need for lots of excitement and taking chances. Many stunt people have this quality. This also represents male bonding as in working out together at a health club or in any physical activity. A male child who embodies some of the qualities mentioned above can be born into a family.

**Neptune=Venus/Midheaven** Natal

Spiritual love, along with the capacity to sense beyond one's normal reality into a visionary world that embraces love as the core factor, is an embodiment of this energy. This also relates to a relationship from a past life, which feels like a soul mate. Many talented musicians, artists, photographers, and actors carry this energy.

**Neptune=Jupiter/Pluto** Natal

On its highest level, one has the capacity to be a psychic healer and/or psychic surgeon with the ability to heal one's physical and spiritual woundedness. Spiritually, one has the capacity to lead the masses with one's greatness of beliefs and philosophy on life. This leading can be done through public speaking, tapes, or as a famous artisan. There's the ability to watch one's old worn-out patterns disintegrate, then witnessing the birthing of new ones. On the reverse side, there's a tendency to manipulate and try to gain something

out of someone through deception or fraud; thus, this could be a very difficult time in one's life, depending on one's intent to grow or to stay where they are.

**Neptune=Midheaven/Ascendant** Natal

One can change their personal appearance now or there can be a fading into the crowd effect. People, who have this are healthy and don't want to waste their energy. There may be a desire to help people less fortunate than one's self, but this could be a drain on one's energy over an extended period of time. Be sure and stay away from addictive behavior like drugs, caffeine, nicotine, and alcohol. There could also be sleep disorders. Medically, this tends to drain one's energy and gives problems with the musculature. The best thing one could do is to work out or do yoga. Remember no matter how difficult the strain may be at first, you will feel 100 percent better in a short time.

**Midheaven=Moon/Mars** Natal

One can be involved in a business that provides for the emotional needs of others. Or it may be working among women of personal power or a powerful woman in the professional field. There can be advancement on a professional level due to new innovative ideas, combined with the desire to be first in line or a step ahead of the game. It means to take the initiative and get the ball rolling which can lead to success later. This can also denote the angry mother who seems to have lots of energy and a strong will to succeed in her personal pursuits.

**Midheaven=Moon/Uranus** Natal

There can be many career changes taking place within one's profession, and there is a tendency to draw upon the use of higher intellect that needs to be applied to the work. This could come in the form of writing or teaching what one knows. The unstable home life or volatile parent, is a representation of this. There can be sudden career advancements in the career due to being a visionary or having associations with highly intellectual women.

**Midheaven=Mars/Pluto** Natal

This is one of the great transformative energies that can be used in one's career. One may have great physical strength, like a body builder or a person who seeks self-mastery. On the negative side, there can be a power struggle with others or a person who wants to be a dictator using their power to control others. Medically this rules surgery, and transitions or the procreation of life along with the life force coming in and going out.

**Midheaven=Uranus/Pluto** Natal

This is inspirational relating to transformational changes in one's life or career direction. It represents the ability to transform and change the present situation either forcefully or through an ending. Many times this relates to the need for surgery on the circulatory system or heart. It may also represent sudden transitions within the family.

**Ascendant=Venus (Beautiful Appearance)** Natal

Venus and the Ascendant combine physical appearance with beauty. This effects the environment through the creation of a beautiful place with pleasant ambiance. Many interior decorators have this energy since they can combine a sense of artistic beauty with the knowledge of placement. Artists, dancers and singers have this, as do hairdressers,

representing a large full head of beautiful luxurious hair which people notice first about you. There can also be the capacity to be a good listener and to hear what someone is saying; thus this represents acute hearing abilities. It denotes the person who walks in beauty with beautiful inviting eyes, presenting a beautiful face to the world. People with this influence have a very pleasant appearance. There is talent for combining colors together with an artistic flair. Many people use this energy to get their hair cut and styled and go on a shopping spree, since this relates to spending money on one's self. On the shadow side, there can be over indulgence in areas of pleasure, thus this relates to the pleasure seeker who wastes time and money. There is also a tendency to party too much, always wanting to feel good and not accomplishing much or using energy incorrectly. This denotes the narcissist.

## Active Midpoints: Apr 24, 2008 to Apr 24, 2009

When interpreting the active midpoints one should keep in mind that the strongest midpoint is the one that is activating a natal midpoint. Thus if your natal midpoint has been activated by transit or progression/direction, then the possibility of the events happening are much stronger. The transits to that natal midpoint seem to be the final timer on an event, which could be indicated in the birth chart. These interpretations address not only what could likely happen for the self but also for others. These midpoints also relate to medical issues, which could be for the self and or others around you. Many times these interpretations medically will have already been addressed, since one may have been working on their personal habits long before, thus arresting any ill effects from the midpoint. The activation of midpoints can happen as early as 1 degree or the equivalent of one year ahead of the exact hit, thus it's good to really look ahead at the energy being activated (by directed planets especially) during the coming year. The active midpoints look at our potential for personal growth, act as a guide for our future and can be used as an adjunct to the usual techniques of interpretive astrology.

### **Apr 24, 2008**      **Uranus = Sun/Node**      Transit

One has the capacity to bring in unique people that help to advance one's knowledge. It could be joining a group of astrologers and linking or connecting with others on a mental level. This also manifests as the joining of a group interested in advancement through higher forms of communications. This represents the conception or birth of an unusual, unique, and often a rebellious child.

### **May 15, 2008**      **Moon = Jupiter/Node**      Progressed

Connecting with women who form a new family circle is a representation of this energy; thus there's a new appreciation for the soul connections being made. These connections will play more of a spiritual and nurturing role in the lives of those around oneself; thus helping to heal old family wounds.

### **May 26, 2008**      **Saturn = Venus/Pluto**      Transit

There can be an intense financial struggle and/or delay or slow progress in one's financial advancement. Couples can separate if they don't work out their finances by paying off their debts, thus needing to grow closer together in values. There can also be separations from people one works with because of lay offs in the work environment. One can grow and advance due to learning about the value of delays and the need to focus more on what one's basic needs are, thus making use of resources and not squandering them.

### **May 28, 2008**      **Saturn = Pluto/Ascendant**      Transit

This tends to make one feel confined within their environment, and it seems to make one

stay in one location for long periods of time. There's a tendency to have a more serious quality to the personality; thus, this builds character and stamina with the capacity to withstand the storm. This relates to caring for a parent and/or a person who has health issues for an extended period of time. Medically, this tends to confine and limit, thus this denotes arthritis, bone disease, and any disease that is considered chronic, and it relates to tooth extractions.

**Jun 01, 2008      Jupiter = Uranus/Midheaven      Transit**

There can be sudden fame and good fortune. One can also speculate and win, as well as connect on a social level to others who are successful. This relates to the successful astrologer or anyone who is successful on the Internet, with computers, or anything considered high tech or state of the art. This is present when one enters or leaves college, as well as when one computerizes or upgrades software or information.

**Jun 04, 2008      Jupiter = Mars/Midheaven      Transit**

Success can come now through one's actions or activities and there can be happiness through the career. Decisions seem to go in one's favor. Many times a woman can meet a man who will bring in opportunities and/or a successful change in their life's path. Business opportunities can come in now and/or there could be pay off of a business venture.

**Jun 08, 2008      Saturn = Moon/Venus      Transit**

There can be emotional blocks in relationships that can cause separations due to repeating the patterns of our parents; this, in fact, could even relate to the breakup of a family. Usually there is an ability to discipline the feelings that can help one to be able to make decisions without attachment. One has the capacity to run a family business and make it successful and also, as time passes, there can be the responsibility of an aging parent put on one's shoulders. There may be the desire to build a beautiful structure and/or home which has a sense of stability and security. This also relates to financial concerns and/or a point where we pay off loans and create new long-term investments.

**Jun 09, 2008      Saturn = Moon/Ascendant      Transit**

Separation from others in the family or from the business family is a manifestation of this. It can cause one to feel depressed or confined when in this place. There could be slow maturation of the physical body and/or smaller features. One can either have beautiful skin or acne on the face, since this rules our face to the world. There is also a feeling of being limited by others or of facing the world alone. Usually there are unions formed now which have karmic repercussions or there may even be a marriage for security reasons. On the positive side, this represents a time of weight loss due to the lack of appetite or not being able to stomach the situation.

**Jun 09, 2008      Jupiter = Jupiter/Saturn      (Expansion and Contraction)      Transit**

When Jupiter and Saturn come together, one is either expanding outward and/or contracting inward. This manifests through the purchase of a larger home, which could even be the home of one's dreams. There can also be a focus on one's career -- going from one position to another, having a change in pay or a raise -- thus giving a more solid financial foundation. With regards to big business, one can have flexibility to expand and or downsize, depending upon what is needed. On the reverse side, there is a feeling of not

enough or potential financial difficulties, often due to having overextended oneself. Thus the conservation of one's energy and waiting to see the outcome, knowing that one can get what they want at a later date, is important. A long hard look at what one values should be taken, along with the desire to expand one's personal awareness into other areas of life. Medically this rules the liver, the blood, as in one's blood pressure, which, on a metaphorical level, may have something to do with blockages within one's belief system.

**Jun 22, 2008 \* Saturn = Sun/Mercury Transit**

One is usually known for their organizational skills and their constructive way of thinking. Thus this gives the ability to relate easily to authority figures with the capability of organizing a complicated system, especially where big business is involved. It can also represent long periods of study that will help advance one in their career. On the other side of this, there can be separations due to blocks in communication with authorities, co-workers, and/or loved ones because of a need to be right on both sides. This can also lead to depression due to not being able to express one's thoughts and/or feelings, as though others are not really hearing them.

**Jun 25, 2008 Moon = Jupiter/Saturn Progressed**

There is a desire to move forward in life by expanding in one's surroundings. Thus, there can be a purchasing of a new home and/or remodeling or doing major repairs on one's existing residence. On a psychological level, one may want to overcome early feelings of not having enough, or feeling less than enough, possibly because there just wasn't enough -- either way, it addresses our lack of emotional stability. This is present when a woman is trying to overcome difficult circumstances due to the lack of education and/or early family limitations that have held her back from her full potential.

**Jun 25, 2008 Jupiter = Jupiter/Node (Successful Associations) Transit**

Jupiter/Node brings successful and pleasant associations into our life, as it relates to abundant people who are influential in the community, having knowledge or financial success. These are the connections one makes which help them to change their future direction. One can meet someone now with whom they would like to marry and share their future. There can also be the birth of a child who brings much pleasure into one's life. Connections can be made now with foreigners who share their beliefs and philosophy on life. On a professional level, this relates to connecting with people who are in key positions to help advance one's career; thus this is an important time for business success created through bonding with others.

**Jun 28, 2008 Mars = Mercury/Neptune Direction: Solar Arc**

The act of perception and using a new understanding to create through the spoken word is a manifestation of this energy. This can be done in a sensual way through the use of alluring words or sensual talk. On the reverse side of this, one may act out their fantasies through sexual thoughts put into words as in on-line phone sex or the 1-900 lines. It rules the mental creative mental talent an artist possesses. To be betrayed by a man through his words, or meeting a man from a past life with whom there has been passionate love being exchanged is a manifestation of this. On a medical level this affects the appendix as in appendicitis, and inflammation of the cells, swelling, blisters, or burns on the hands or

fingers. A good way to use this energy is to do Hatha Yoga, which combines energy, breathing, and meditation into one system to boost one's health and healing of the immune system.

**Jul 06, 2008 \* Moon = Mars/Midheaven** Progressed

Willful, independent women relate to this energy, or having to deal with an excitable woman in some area of life. One may have to deal with a strong-willed parent and/or boss with a rather dominant personality. Either way, life seems to be dominated by the emotions of another. On the positive side, one can get a lot done in a short amount of time, since there's the will to do it their own way by enhancing their personal objectives.

**Jul 09, 2008 Pluto = Node (Transformational Associations)** Transit

When Pluto and the Node come together, associations can come into one's life that can transform. These connections are usually intense and have an end goal or an intention. This relates to influential people, such as a political leader or someone who has control over the masses. This also relates to large groups of people who come together for a common purpose that transforms the existing policy. This can be the beginning or ending of very important associations that could ultimately change one's life for the better. These connections are karmic in that they help us to advance quickly on a soul level. On a psychological level, this brings awareness of others and the consciousness of self and yet there's the potential to lose consciousness of others by not knowing how they really feel. This denotes transitions and births of people to whom we are very close and is rules the reproductive cycle.

**Jul 11, 2008 \* Moon = Uranus/Midheaven** Progressed

One has the capacity to move up in the world and/or make a big move for their employment, which usually happens suddenly. This may manifest by moving to a completely different type of place. This also relates to the volatile mother who has many mood swings and could have a chemical imbalance. But on the positive side, there could be the gathering of a group of women for the attainment of knowledge.

**Jul 12, 2008 Jupiter = Moon/Uranus** Transit

This is the strongest energy pointing to the astrologer in the zodiac. It represents sudden success in life and a person who speculates and wins, thus one may play the lottery and/or take chances which they normally wouldn't take otherwise. There could be positive recognition for the application of one's intellectual abilities and the desire to study advanced subjects, such as computer technology and/or astrology. This also manifests by going on to college or university; either way it's a period of enlightenment gained through advancing one's desire to learn. There is also a desire to share the knowledge learned with others through writing a book, which could be published.

**Jul 14, 2008 Jupiter = Moon/Mars** Transit

There is a love of travel, especially to warm, hot places. This can cause legal problems surrounding the family and/or real estate matters and there can be heated discussions regarding the belief systems and philosophy of others. This also rules the physically large woman and/or the large breasted female. Medically, there can be weight gain due to chemical imbalance in the diet along with an over acid condition.

**Jul 14, 2008**      **Jupiter = Midheaven**      **(Successful Business)**      Transit

Jupiter, when in combination with the MC, gives great success within one's career along with potential opportunities to expand and move up in the world. This energy relates to heights, thus one could reach their career heights under this influence. People may move from one location to another, which denotes moving to a larger home and/or work or to another country. Usually there can be opportunities laid out by a grandparent and/or the inheriting the family business. People who do a lot of travel for business, especially to foreign lands, have this, and they seem to do well when in business with or for foreigners. On a medical level this relates to a successful outcome to the diagnosis and it denotes the prominent doctor.

**Jul 17, 2008**      **Jupiter = Uranus/Pluto**      Transit

One has a sudden rise to power with great financial success, and many great astrologers who are researchers carry this energy. This relates to suddenly winning a large amount of money. Legal matters come to a head under this, causing reforms and changes with regards to the overall legal system. This also represents having to deal with the IRS and/or large banking and lending institutions. Medically there can be a positive outcome with surgeries. And it relates to the transition of a grandparent, thus there can be an inheritance with money coming from an estate.

**Jul 19, 2008**      **Jupiter = Mars/Pluto**      Transit

The birth of a power child and/or the birth of powerful children are a manifestation of this energy. It relates to the use of energy that is wielded through philosophy and belief systems, thus transformative thought. People who can change the world through what they believe or do carry this energy. So this rules a surgeon and/or represents plastic surgery and it relates to the medical profession, or a doctor who has the capacity to deal with life and death situations. The transition of a grandparent can also come under this.

**Jul 26, 2008**      **Jupiter = Saturn/Ascendant**      Transit

Moving up in the world due to opportunities that take one out of their former limitations is a manifestation of this energy. There's a desire to move from a smaller home to a larger one. This relates to people who have come from a limited, confined position early in life, with little joy or happiness. Thus this gives one the capacity to value hard work and saving for that potential rainy day. Medically this relates to the liver, so be sure to drink lots of water.

**Jul 26, 2008**      **Jupiter = Venus/Saturn**      Transit

This relates to a partnership trying to move forward on a financial level but which still has to deal with periods of delay and slow progress. It can be a time to slow down and hold back economically, since it denotes overextending one's resources and finances through the "good life" and then having to pay the piper. There can also be separation in partnerships due to differences in values and/or for financial reasons. This also relates to down sizing or being conservative within a partnership.

**Jul 28, 2008**      **Saturn = Venus/Midheaven**      Transit

One may find that they are delayed in the advancement of the career, or there could be separation from those one works or partners with. This can also be a period of forced growth due to a lack of knowledge or social skills; thus, one can advance quickly once

they've learned these skills and developed a better sense of timing and career management. Financially, this is usually a time when it's better to invest in one's own advancement, and it's not a time to take money out of the business.

**Jul 28, 2008 Saturn = Neptune (Spiritual Teachers) Transit**

When Saturn combines with Neptune there is the decay of the old and the rebuilding of new structures, thus there is a bridging of one consciousness to another. During the last Saturn Neptune conjunction (1989), there were many bridges that collapsed and had to be rebuilt. One has the ability to go into a dreamtime state of reality and become a channel for information on other levels of consciousness. The highest manifestation of this energy is represented by a spiritual teacher who has great wisdom, developed over a period of lifetimes, to share with humanity. On the other side, there can be problems within one's work or partnerships due to fraud or deceit. There is also a tendency to dissolve dreams, causing a feeling of great depression which could result in substance abuse or drug poisoning; this can also affect the father in all of the above issues. There can be a lack of timing and or a feeling of not being in touch with reality. Medically, this rules bone disintegration, as in tooth decay, arthritis, broken toes, and/or foot disorders, along with bone diseases and cancer, due to its wasting away effect. It's also present with alcoholism and drug abuse, which is of a habitual nature.

**Jul 28, 2008 Saturn = Midheaven/Ascendant Transit**

This has a sobering effect in that there may be periods of isolation from others, or a feeling that one needs to be alone. This builds personal character and stability due to relying on the self versus others. There can also be a period where one is limited by a situation, or one may have to take care of the needs of another. On a medical level, this tends to cause ailments that limit, like arthritis, as well as having problems with the teeth and/or bone structure, denoting chronic ailments.

**Jul 31, 2008 Saturn = Jupiter/Pluto Transit**

Separation from others due to fixed beliefs and/or the feeling of being indoctrinated by others is a representation of this energy. Once one learns the lesson of separation due to one's philosophy, then one understands how to use their personal will power. In the career area, one has the capacity to run the company, since this energy relates to big business and the power of control, which only someone at the top has. On the shadow side, there may have been obstacles that have prevented one from advancing in life, due to inhibitions created within the early environment.

**Aug 06, 2008 Saturn = Moon/Jupiter Transit**

One can come from a strong heritage or background with a need for family security, since the financial needs take precedence. There is usually a desire to expand from a smaller environment into a larger one, and there can be many family responsibilities, especially involving the care of a parent's needs. Sometimes one may feel as though they didn't get the chance they needed out of life to pursue higher education, thus it might be gained on the job and/or slowly over a period of years. This represents philosophical restrictions as well as having the ability to focus on a religious career. It denotes the grandfather and/or a business started by a grandparent. On a mundane level, there could be a need to replace

a household appliance, like a refrigerator or air conditioner.

**Aug 07, 2008**      **Neptune = Node/Midheaven**      Transit

People come together who want to manifest a similar dream. It connects spiritual groups and people that help one to attain a higher level of development. On the other side of this, there can be problems attaining personal goals due to associations with people who aren't contributing their energy or are deceptive with regard to what they really want. Thus there can be endings to partnerships due to lack of participation. Medically this relates to addictions and diseases, which seem to waste away the body, thus it's good to get a checkup in advance. There is also the potential for the father to have substance abuse issues. This relates to helping someone who is ill and/or less fortunate than oneself.

**Aug 11, 2008**      **Jupiter = Node/Ascendant**      Transit

Many fortunate contacts and associations can come in, bringing influential people into one's life that can change it for the better. This rules traveling and/or learning with others, connecting people together to attain higher knowledge. Many people who have a fortunate turn in their life's circumstances have this, as well as people who were born into prosperity, an economically secure family, or who have the ability to manifest success through their own talents.

**Aug 12, 2008**      **Jupiter = Venus/Node**      Transit

This relates to great success, since it creates connections that help one to advance and expand in their life's path. It represents the people who are influential in one's life and whose philosophy and belief systems affect one in a positive way. Many times one meets the person they want to marry and are happy for many years to come.

**Aug 20, 2008**      **Saturn = Sun/Neptune**      Transit

One can dissolve old structures by the rebuilding of new ones. This represents the bridge of consciousness created when we follow our spiritual path. It can also represent a physical bridge over a body of water; thus, on a psychological level, this relates to a bridge over troubled waters. On the negative side, there can be issues surrounding desertion and/or substance abuse on the part of the father. On a professional level, there can be betrayal within the work environment or a slow disintegration of the business. Medically this weakens the immune system, thus causing a wasting-away effect. This rules the potential cancer of one's philosophy, thus manifesting as liver disease caused by the lack of good judgment. There can also be tooth decay, osteoporosis, and weakened bones due to poor assimilation of calcium. It's important to have clear intent along with sound values as one's guide through life.

**Sep 01, 2008**      **Uranus = Sun/Node**      Transit

One has the capacity to bring in unique people that help to advance one's knowledge. It could be joining a group of astrologers and linking or connecting with others on a mental level. This also manifests as the joining of a group interested in advancement through higher forms of communications. This represents the conception or birth of an unusual, unique, and often a rebellious child.

**Sep 03, 2008**      **Saturn = Venus/Mars**      Transit

This relates to separation in love due to sexual indiscretions and/or financial difficulties.

It gives one a feeling of being betrayed on a sexual level, or one may need to work on sexual issues within the relationship. There can also be sexual harassment in the work environment or attraction to someone in the work place. Often one can have repression due to sexual disfunction, or delay in sexual maturation.

**Sep 03, 2008      Saturn = Mars/Ascendant      Transit**

One can hold themselves back from their full potential due to early inhibitions. Thus, if one works with their early environmental conditioning they could overcome some of the obstacles that seem to hold them back or keep them in the same place without advancement. People who have this seem to have physical strength and a sense of purpose. One usually has the intention to somehow get the job done no matter what the obstacles are. There can also be sadness which is shared with others due to a loss or concern for others.

**Sep 04, 2008      Saturn = Mercury/Node      Transit**

Saturn usually disconnects people or causes them to separate for a period of time, thus this could separate one from a sibling or relative. One has the capacity to work with a boss, as this relates to the person who runs a work force. There can be connecting up with a new boss, or separating from a co-worker, or a separation of thought. Thus, one may feel alone from those they used to feel close to. And there may be the loss of, or block in, communication with relatives. On the positive side, one may master a particular subject along with others to form a group thought or awareness.

**Sep 05, 2008      Saturn = Venus/Uranus      Transit**

Separations from friends or difficulty in relationships -- either due to going in different directions or not spending enough time with each other to truly develop and nurture the relationship -- is a manifestation of this energy. There can also be controlled response in a relationship in one's love life or a feeling of a change in one's capacity to love. Thus, this denotes the sobering up process within a relationship. On the positive side, one may have new friends come in through a job change or a change of personnel within the present job.

**Sep 05, 2008      Saturn = Uranus/Ascendant      Transit**

This relates to making sudden changes surrounding one's structure. It gives the capacity to be rather unpredictable and yet, on the opposite side, very conventional. This seems to be the enigma effect in that there is a need to be in the present moment. The negative side of this energy can be where one takes chances and is always finding new ways to individuate from others. On a daily level, this is good for making changes suddenly, as in the residence and or job structure. Medically, this relates to a break and or problems with the teeth. Staying in harmony with one's environmental circumstances is very important.

**Sep 11, 2008      Saturn = Sun      (The Disciple)      Transit**

The Sun represents the self and Saturn is discipline, thus this denotes the disciplining of the self through restraint and focus. There's a sense of timing and structure, which helps one to become more stable; thus giving the capacity to develop better habits. There is also the desire to eliminate negative habits and to replace them with something that could forego the test of time. Saturn, who is known as father time, represents the need to get a better sense of timing along with the need to set long-range goals and plans for the future.

Thus preparing one for that potential rainy day. This may also represent having to care for the needs of a child, or children, who needs help in their early development. This is a time of little pleasure, just learning how to discipline the self, thus attaining future security in life. Many times the father can have potential health problems now, and people with this may have a tendency to harden their hearts due to long periods of no love and/or not giving love out of fear of rejection. Thus this can lead to hardening of the arteries. Usually one puts their attention on work instead of love, or they do not love the self, and/or they give selfless love. It also can be the block in love or a delay in getting the love one needs. This represents being separated from others and/or from one's sense of self. In the career area, there can be layoffs or downsizing on a professional level. Thus, this relates to financial losses or a time to save one's money so that one can advance forward in the future. One has a feeling that nothing is handed to them, since they work hard for everything they have attained.

**Sep 18, 2008      Saturn = Mercury/Saturn      (Concentrated Thought)      Transit**

Mercury and Saturn relate to introspection and concentration of thought since one has the potential to become deeply fixed into a mental pattern that is either favorable or not. Thus, depression comes easily and one tends to only see the glass as half empty. There can also be mental blocks along with difficult communications with the father and/or boss. One may have problems feeling as though they can't share their thoughts with a sibling, which could lead to a separation from the sibling for an extended period of time. There can be difficulty due to the inability of others to understand what is trying to be communicated and/or they just don't feel the same way, thus, direct and effective communication is most important, especially in the work environment. **Oct 04, 2008      Jupiter = Node/Ascendant      Transit**

Many people who have a fortunate turn in their life's circumstances have this, as well as people who were born into prosperity, an economically secure family, or who have the ability to manifest success through their own talents.

**Oct 20, 2008      Saturn = Mars/Jupiter      Transit**

Dealing with authorities is a representation of this energy, as well as having the capacity to combine physical strength along with timing. Thus, many construction workers and builders have this energy. There can also be expansion in one's life through building new structures. This is a time of overcoming the limitations that have been holding one back from their full potential. Many times there are breaks and separations from others due to not shifting one's position, since this relates to obstinacy.

**Oct 20, 2008      Jupiter = Venus/Saturn      Transit**

**Oct 21, 2008      Jupiter = Saturn/Ascendant      Transit**

This relates to people who have come from a limited, confined position early in life, with little joy or happiness. Thus this gives one the capacity to value hard work and saving for that potential rainy day. Medically this relates to the liver, so be sure to drink lots of water.

**Oct 22, 2008**      **Saturn = Jupiter/Uranus**      Transit

This energy relates to a person who dedicates their life to the advancement of the social order, with lots of blocks from the establishment along the way. One has a desire for freedom from the way things are, thus people tend to quit their job or even a relationship for the quest of that newfound freedom. There can also be difficulties in life due to the lack of an education in one's specialized field, thus there are problems moving up the ladder of success. This is also a good time to seek out higher education and/or training that could give the desired skills which are necessary for personal advancement. One also has writing skills, as in writing a long novel or documenting information for historical archives, since this relates to historians.

**Oct 22, 2008**      **Moon = Mars**      **(Emotional Response)**      Progressed

Emotionally charged women who are highly energetic and fast to react are examples of this energy and/or it's the emotionally young person who is very assertive to their family and friends. There are many flare-ups and heated issues that can come up while in the presence of others, and this relates to the angry woman and/or mother with deep emotional scars caused by early childhood development. This also relates to getting angry and then getting over it just as fast. On a lighter note, this represents people who work on new projects surrounding the home or family, and it relates to emotional courage. It gives the ability to arouse the emotions of others to a new cause and it relates to many sports enthusiasts and/or women involved in sports. There can be a love of spicy foods and even the beginning of a new diet. It also relates to living in a hot climate and/or to buying a new family home. Medically this rules the sensitive stomach, resulting in an overly acidic condition or possibly an ulcer created by internalized anger. **Oct 27, 2008**      **Jupiter = Mars/Pluto**      Transit

The birth of a power child and/or the birth of powerful children are a manifestation of this energy. It relates to the use of energy that is wielded through philosophy and belief systems, thus transformative thought. People who can change the world through what they believe or do carry this energy. So this rules a surgeon and/or represents plastic surgery and it relates to the medical profession, or a doctor who has the capacity to deal with life and death situations. **Oct 27, 2008**      **Moon = Mars/Uranus**      Progressed

**Oct 29, 2008      Saturn = Neptune/Node      Transit**

This denotes someone who has health problems or is being deceitful in a relationship where they have hidden their true nature or desires. Either way, this can leave one feeling betrayed and alone, suffering in silence. Medically, this relates to bone disease due to not feeling supported by others, or skin ailments from toxicity in the diet. There can also be substance abuse on the part of the father's lineage and/or toxic substances within the work area which affect the health.

**Oct 31, 2008      Jupiter = Midheaven      (Successful Business)      Transit**

Jupiter, when in combination with the MC, gives great success within one's career along with potential opportunities to expand and move up in the world. This energy relates to heights, thus one could reach their career heights under this influence. People may move from one location to another, which denotes moving to a larger home and/or work or to another country. Usually there can be opportunities laid out by a grandparent and/or the inheriting the family business. People who do a lot of travel for business, especially to foreign lands, have this, and they seem to do well when in business with or for foreigners. On a medical level this relates to a successful outcome to the diagnosis and it denotes the prominent doctor.

**Oct 31, 2008      Jupiter = Moon/Mars      Transit**

There is a love of travel, especially to warm, hot places. This can cause legal problems surrounding the family and/or real estate matters and there can be heated discussions regarding the belief systems and philosophy of others. This also rules the physically large woman and/or the large breasted female. Medically, there can be weight gain due to chemical imbalance in the diet along with an over acid condition.

**Nov 02, 2008      Moon = Uranus      (Independent Feelings)      Progressed**

Emotional independence and the ability to be self-willed, along with being highly, intelligent yet excitable, is a manifestation of this energy. This relates to a woman or a person who has clairvoyance and inner sight. One may make many moves from home to home, having a need to keep changing their personal environment. There can also be an unstable, eccentric mother or woman in their life. Or one may have the desire to become part of an extremist movement, thus becoming more of an independent person. This also relates to large groups of people who come together for a common purpose that transforms the existing policy. On a psychological level, this brings awareness of others and the consciousness of self and yet there's the potential to lose consciousness of others by not knowing how they really feel. This denotes transitions and births of people to whom we are very close and is rules the reproductive cycle.

**Nov 15, 2008**      **Jupiter = Jupiter/Node**      **(Successful Associations)**      Transit

Jupiter/Node brings successful and pleasant associations into our life, as it relates to abundant people who are influential in the community, having knowledge or financial success. These are the connections one makes which help them to change their future direction. One can meet someone now with whom they would like to marry and share their future. There can also be the birth of a child who brings much pleasure into one's life. Connections can be made now with foreigners who share their beliefs and philosophy on life. On a professional level, this relates to connecting with people who are in key positions to help advance one's career; thus this is an important time for business success created through bonding with others.

**Nov 17, 2008**      **Saturn = Saturn/Neptune**      **(Spiritual Teachers)**      Transit

When Saturn combines with Neptune there is the decay of the old and the rebuilding of new structures, thus there is a bridging of one consciousness to another. During the last Saturn Neptune conjunction (1989), there were many bridges that collapsed and had to be rebuilt. One has the ability to go into a dreamtime state of reality and become a channel for information on other levels of consciousness. The highest manifestation of this energy is represented by a spiritual teacher who has great wisdom, developed over a period of lifetimes, to share with humanity. On the other side, there can be problems within one's work or partnerships due to fraud or deceit. There is also a tendency to dissolve dreams,

causing a feeling of great depression which could result in substance abuse or drug poisoning; this can also affect the father in all of the above issues. There can be a lack of timing and or a feeling of not being in touch with reality. **Nov 27, 2008**     **Jupiter = Uranus/Midheaven**     Transit

There can be sudden fame and good fortune. One can also speculate and win, as well as connect on a social level to others who are successful. This relates to the successful astrologer or anyone who is successful on the Internet, with computers, or anything considered high tech or state of the art. This is present when one enters or leaves college, as well as when one computerizes or upgrades software or information.

**Dec 04, 2008**     **Saturn = Sun/Node**     Transit

Many times this is the father and/or boss -- the one who is in the authority position. This could be connecting with a new boss, or when one is separating from a group of people they have worked with for a long period of time. This also relates to feeling confined within a karmic association which is shared with others.

**Dec 10, 2008      Moon = Venus      (The Marriage)      Progressed**

The Moon combined with Venus relates to the marriage based on the power of love and attraction. It denotes beautiful women, who have sensitivity to the needs of others or the beautiful environment and the happy family, thus creating beauty in one's life. One has the capacity to emotionally respond to the desires of others, as well as feel happiness while in the presence of family members. Having a beautiful face and hair and the overall liking of what is seen in the mirror is represented by this energy. There is usually a capacity to do interior decorating along with a love of colors and textures. This also denotes the ability to be very socially oriented with the love of a good party. Jupiter combined with the Ascendant expands the environment and/or physical body, which could manifest in the form of excess through one's weight or height or sheer size. One could also be the lean lanky type, having a runner's body and, in fact, this energy does relate to runners and/or tennis players. There is a love of travel and/or moving from one home to another, which is usually larger. There's also the desire for a more spiritual environment where one can practice the expansion of the belief system. There can be important people who come into one's space who seem to nourish the belief in a higher order through expanded awareness. The luck of the Irish is here, giving success and/or fame. Many people experience a desire to move from one location to a larger, more spacious environment where they can share their good fortune with others. This relates to people who move early in life to a new location that is far from their birthplace where they may live out the rest of their life.

**Jan 08, 2009      Jupiter = Mercury/Pluto      Transit**

There can be a lot of talk about large sums of money or talking about an estate as this relates to estates. Occult knowledge being shared with others is also a manifestation of this energy, as well as schools specializing in teaching hidden wisdom. There can be a birth of a sibling or dealing with a sibling who has transformational abilities. **Jan 10, 2009      Jupiter = Moon/Mercury      Transit**

**Jan 20, 2009 Jupiter = Jupiter/Ascendant (Expansive Environment) Transit**

Jupiter combined with the Ascendant expands the environment and/or physical body, which could manifest in the form of excess through one's weight or height or sheer size. One could also be the lean lanky type, having a runner's body and, in fact, this energy does relate to runners and/or tennis players. There is a love of travel and/or moving from one home to another, which is usually larger. There's also the desire for a more spiritual environment where one can practice the expansion of the belief system. There can be important people who come into one's space who seem to nourish the belief in a higher

There is an element of excitability here due to the need for change in the present circumstance. Medically, this denotes illnesses which can come without warning, thus shaking one to the core of there being, leaving one unsure of what the future may bring.

**Jan 27, 2009      Saturn = Sun/Node      Transit**

Many times this is the father and/or boss -- the one who is in the authority position. This could be connecting with a new boss, or when one is separating from a group of people they have worked with for a long period of time. This also relates to feeling confined within a karmic association which is shared with others.

**Jan 28, 2009      Ascendant = Sun/Mercury      Direction: Solar Arc**

This relates to the place where one can communicate well with others or the place where one writes. There can be talking with a sibling or communications with someone new. In this location one has the ability to express themselves easily and with comfort to others of like mind. This is the place to create or to make crafts.

**Jan 29, 2009      Jupiter = Mercury/Midheaven      Transit**

One has a fresh optimistic outlook towards life, along with the capacity to have good fortune in the career due to making the right decisions at the right time. There can be potential success as a writer and/or publicist as well as having skills in public relations. There can also be excellent communication with a grandparent and an ability to express one's self in a manner which brings advancement in one's career and/or receiving a raise or hearing good news surrounding the career.

**Feb 03, 2009      Mars = Mercury/Midheaven      Progressed**

Awareness of the impact our thoughts and words have on others is a reflection of this energy. It deals with how we process information and how we act on it; thus one usually has efficiency in the communications area. It also causes one to react suddenly to what someone else says or does, as well as giving speed with the hands, as in being a fast typist or talker in business. One usually rises to the top of their career quickly due to good communication skills.

**Feb 03, 2009 \*      Jupiter = Neptune/Pluto      Transit**

One can become highly religious under this, dedicating themselves to a belief system along with a desire to propagate the faith. There's the potential for universal love of humanity and the gift to see beyond this present reality. There could be research into the metaphysical side of things which may be very successful, especially in working with dreamtime. On the other side of the coin, this relates to gambling and/or wasting one's energy on foolish things that probably won't take form and/or manifest anyway. This also

represents the spiritual traveler who can take a journey within and/or to a spiritual place on the earth. On a medical level, there could be problems with the liver and/or blood.

**Feb 06, 2009 \***      **Jupiter = Moon/Neptune**      Transit

There can be a psychic grandmother and/or a large woman who has great abundance in one's life, as well as having a strong religious belief with a powerful heritage. There's a desire to feed the masses and/or to give freely the gifts that one has received from others. Many times there is a journey of awareness: the spiritual journey or traveling great distances over water to see family. This relates to the process of entering into dreamtime. On the other side of this, there can be deception in the belief system, being confused by others who have a different philosophy from one self, and/or being judged by others. The great flood, or water problems in the home, is another manifestation of this energy. On a medical level this rules hepatitis, a disease that affects the liver, caused by toxicity in the body. **Feb 13, 2009**      **Pluto = Venus/Neptune**      Transit

There's a sense of the surreal to one's life and a feeling of wanting to have mastery over the senses. There's a power of attraction along with having a haunting feeling for another. This can come in the love one feels for a soul mate. This relates to self-mastery, especially in the art of love, having learned to love without expectation of something in return.

**Feb 13, 2009**      **Moon = Mercury/Pluto**      Progressed

There is a capacity to benefit through the buying and selling of homes or dealing with mortgages. This also gives deep penetrating abilities to reach large groups of people and sway them to one's way of thinking. There's the possibility of having a controlling or willful mother, and there could also be news of the loss of a family member, which has been expected. If this energy is used positively, it can give one the capacity to understand how to transmute negative energy, somewhat like a psychic surgeon.

**Feb 14, 2009**      **Uranus = Sun/Node**      Transit

One has the capacity to bring in unique people that help to advance one's knowledge. It could be joining a group of astrologers and linking or connecting with others on a mental level. This also manifests as the joining of a group interested in advancement through higher forms of communications. This represents the conception or birth of an unusual, unique, and often a rebellious child.

**Feb 14, 2009**      **Saturn = Saturn/Neptune**      **(Spiritual Teachers)**      Transit

When Saturn combines with Neptune there is the decay of the old and the rebuilding of new structures, thus there is a bridging of one consciousness to another. During the last Saturn Neptune conjunction (1989), there were many bridges that collapsed and had to be rebuilt. One has the ability to go into a dreamtime state of reality and become a channel for information on other levels of consciousness. The highest manifestation of this energy is represented by a spiritual teacher who has great wisdom, developed over a period of lifetimes, to share with humanity. On the other side, there can be problems within one's work or partnerships due to fraud or deceit. There is also a tendency to dissolve dreams,

causing a feeling of great depression which could result in substance abuse or drug poisoning; this can also affect the father in all of the above issues. There can be a lack of timing and or a feeling of not being in touch with reality. Medically, this rules bone disintegration, as in tooth decay, arthritis, broken toes, and/or foot disorders, along with bone diseases and cancer, due to its wasting away effect. It's also present with alcoholism and drug abuse, which is of a habitual nature.

**Feb 15, 2009 Pluto = Neptune/Ascendant Transit**

Transformation of the environment through one's ability to intuit the future is a manifestation of this energy. One has the capacity to be a psychic surgeon and/or healer who can bridge one's consciousness to heal others. On the reverse side, one can wield power and manipulate their environment; thus using their personality to get what they want from others. Medically this rules eliminations and toxicity within the body.

**Feb 15, 2009 \* Jupiter = Sun/Pluto Transit**

These are the people who carry and form the beliefs from one generation to the next. This relates to the study of occult knowledge and an interest in secret societies. Many priests, Shamans, and people who are dedicated to a belief system have this, as well as people who incorporate sexuality with philosophy to attain their personal goals. It relates to books written which affect the consciousness of the masses. This is great for financial gain through an inheritance or an insurance claim, thus this relates to gaining through the transition of a grandparent. It represents the IRS and dealing with our taxes and/or being audited. This is the height of great personal power, creating financial success, and personal gain that results in extreme wealth. There can also be births and transitions within the family under this.

**Feb 16, 2009 Pluto = Saturn (Focused Intent) Transit**

Saturn, when combined with Pluto, has the effect of transformation within the structure, which can manifest in one's career through the ending of one job and beginning of a new one. Thus, there is a death of the old structure along with a birth of the new. A new home or business structure, new management, or even a new work direction are other ways this energy can take form. On the reverse side, there can be dealing with someone's personal power who uses it through ruthless means, or the elimination of one's position. There can also be a boss and/or father who is a controller and who abuses their power and position, or one may become the controller. This has a tendency to create problems for the father due to the potential need for surgery, and there could also be a transition of the dominant parent. **Feb 18, 2009 Jupiter = Mercury/Mars Transit**

This relates to people who usually have a good sense of judgment and/or are involved in the decision making process, such as judges who have a sense of justice and balance when it comes to making decisions for others. This is basically a happy energy that makes one feel that they're in the right and have a good, sound belief system. This also relates to coming into a large sum of money due to sales agreements as well as judgments

that go in one's favor.

**Feb 18, 2009**      **Jupiter = Moon/Sun**      Transit

There can be abundance in one's personal life, and or a child could be born into a wealthy family. It gives the desire to travel and see the world and experience different belief systems and philosophies of other cultures. There is normally a need to move up in the world with this. Thus this is a time of moving and/or expanding in one's personal home. This is one of the influences that gives good luck and opportunities in life, so people with this usually look at life with the glass half full. This relates to the philanthropist and there is a need to have the best education money can buy. Thus it gives one the capacity to be a perpetual student, always in a state of expanding one's personal awareness. This also relates to the sports enthusiast, the hunter, or the person who is struck by Cupid's arrow, thus love is never far away.

**Feb 19, 2009**      **Jupiter = Mercury/Uranus**      Transit

This relates to optimistic people who are fortunate in life as well as having a sibling with the capacity to have a high IQ and excel in academia. One could become a great astrologer, due to the ability to comprehend and synthesize many variables at once. This relates to higher education, university, and specialized schools, thus one has the capacity to be a philosopher and/or teacher of technical subjects. There can also be hearing good news or hearing of good fortune for another. This is also a great time to speculate and win.

**Feb 26, 2009**      **Jupiter = Neptune/Midheaven**      Transit

There can be a love of philosophy, religion, and sharing one's beliefs with others, thus having a desire to share what one has learned on a spiritual level. One may desire to gamble on life and/or with their money, since this relates to speculation. There can be a love of travel or a love of traveling to distant foreign places. There's also a tendency to have grandiose schemes and not always living in the present, with a tendency to live in dreamtime. Medically this rules blood disorders and liver problems.

**Feb 28, 2009**      **Moon = Moon/Mercury (Intuitive Communication)**      Progressed

When the moon combines with Mercury, there is an ability to have intuitive communication, which allows one to express their feelings easily as well as receiving non-verbal queues from others. It's where the emotional and logical mind blend to form one unit. One has the ability to be a good sales person along with very creative ideas. There's usually a very beautiful way of expressing one's self, as well as having a good singing voice and public speaking skills. Many times there is pleasant communication amongst the family members and there could even be a family-run business involving communications and/or sales. Thus this relates to the family lineage, and a strong interest in past history and chronology. There's also the ability to express emotional patterns that can be communicated through one's speech and/or body language. This relates to mimicking of other's speech patterns, or a mime, since there's the ability to express one's self through the reflection of others. **Mar 04, 2009**      **Neptune = Mercury**      **(Intuitive Communication)**      Transit

Mercury with Neptune gives strong intuitions, or perceptions, which, if refined and developed, become profound psychic awareness. One acts as a spiritual channel, passing into higher states of consciousness. There is the capacity to pick up psychic queues from others, which can be used in automatic writing or by storytellers, fictional writers, and even poets. One has the ability to create images and illusions that can be used to create fantasy. When used correctly, one has the capacity to be the true visionary of higher awareness. Many artist and musicians have this energy, combining sound with rhythm. On the negative side, the misuse of this energy can range from people who don't communicate effectively to people who outright lie or deceive others, as well as having a tendency to not hear what someone is saying or misinterpret it. Thus, this can manifest by reverse action, so be sure to only speak the truth. **Mar 05, 2009**      **Neptune = Saturn/Midheaven**      Transit

Spiritual attainment is one of the manifestations of this energy, as it gives one the desire to do the right thing. One has the capacity to help others who are underdogs or weakened, having less than enough. Many times there can be working with the mentally disabled or with substance abusers. This energy is also very karmic, giving problems within the career with the slow disintegration of one's goals. There can also be an alcoholic parent and/or having personal substance abuse issues to deal with. Medically, there is a usurping of one's energy, as in bone disintegration, causing a wasting away effect. Thus, this relates to toxicity causing a serious disease if not corrected and/or diagnosed early enough. In the work area there can be problems with partners, usurping one's power with a slow disintegration of the business.

**Mar 08, 2009**      **Uranus = Venus/Pluto**      Direction: Solar Arc

This is one of the more intensely exciting combinations of the zodiac, due to sudden love bonds created with unusual, free, and unique individuals. There's a desire for higher spiritual awareness through developing an advanced, spiritually connected soul bond with a partner or mate. One has free expression of will, which influences others to see things the same way that they do. Thus, this relates to inspirational people who make a long-term impact upon the life of others through their long-term goals.

**Mar 08, 2009**      **Saturn = Neptune/Node**      Transit

Emotional suffering experienced with others and caused by a highly volatile situation is a manifestation of this, thus there seems to be no way out except through time. This denotes someone who has health problems or is being deceitful in a relationship where they have hidden their true nature or desires. Either way, this can leave one feeling

betrayed and alone, suffering in silence. Medically, this relates to bone disease due to not feeling supported by others, or skin ailments from toxicity in the diet. **Mar 10, 2009 \*      Jupiter = Sun/Midheaven      Transit**

**Mar 10, 2009      Venus = Sun/Mercury      Direction: Solar Arc**

There can be effective communication with the people one loves as well as having the capacity to talk about love with others and/or writing about love. With this, good news can come or one could have pleasant communications with their mate. It represents healthy relationships, where there is good communication between each other. On a professional level, one may have sales skills and the ability to be multifaceted. There is a love of learning and gathering of knowledge, and it also gives artistic skills.

**Mar 16, 2009      Uranus = Sun/Saturn      Transit**

There can be sudden changes in the identity causing the process of individuation to be accelerated. There can also be many changes in the work or management structure within one's professional environment. Often there are upsets in a person's life direction, creating instability due to wavering on decision making. This is a very sudden, drastic type of energy that can cause breakdowns of a car or accidents which usually are not life threatening. Medically, this rules the heartbeat and circulatory system. Thus there may be problems with blockages in the arteries and potential arrhythmia in the heart.

**Mar 17, 2009      Saturn = Jupiter/Uranus      Transit**

This also relates to people who try to control through economic power, as in the IRS, or a banker, or a life insurance company. **Mar 28, 2009**      **Jupiter = Moon/Node**      Transit

A group of women discussing their beliefs and philosophy on life is represented by this energy. It's the loving and nurturing family and/or grandmother. There can be happiness through one's connections and enjoying prosperity with others. **Mar 29, 2009**      **Uranus = Pluto/Ascendant**      Direction: Solar Arc

This has the potential to be a good time to

**Apr 03, 2009**      **Jupiter = Sun/Uranus**      Transit

This is the main signature of the astrologer and/or it gives one the capacity to study difficult subjects like astrology. It rules the high tech and computer industries, thus giving one the capacity to master difficult subjects with ease. Usually people go on to college and/or seek out some form of higher education that is very enjoyable to them. **Apr 03, 2009**      **Jupiter = Saturn/Pluto**      Transit

This relates to large sums of money, where one's activities are kept secret. Sounds like a major deal and that it is, so be sure to pay taxes and have nothing to hide from these institutions, lest one be caught in their web. **Apr 07, 2009**      **Jupiter = Moon/Saturn**      Transit

**Apr 22, 2009**      **Moon = Venus/Jupiter**      Progressed
