Introduction

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sow." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits, adventures,

travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

The Past Life Chart Structure

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

The Passport

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

Node in Aries

You had a history of making a bold statement about your identity. One of your key impulses was to move with a sense of urgency. Your soul was anxious to reincarnate to get on with the work you needed to accomplish. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a spontaneous initiator. A crucial lesson was patience, with a capital "P". You got so self-absorbed you forgot to pay attention to others. It was difficult for you to focus long on objectives that didn't capture your attention. Discipline was something you worried about halfway into a project.

You needed to have a me-focus when you gave too much of yourself away to others. A trickster was excessively trying to be a crowd-pleaser. This caused you to get lost in indecision. Finding a way to balance the scales of me versus them was vital to your happiness. Partnerships played a major role in your incarnations. When you fell in love, it made you feel alive. Your adrenaline poured through you forcefully, making you want to be a doer. But when you were unhappy in love, or got rejected, you became confused. It was then that you had to muster the courage to walk forward. Actions with deeper awareness illuminated your life directions and pointed the way to harmony.

Node in 7th house

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? Relationships played a big part. If you became either too self-centered, or lacked assertiveness, life had many more uncertainties than you liked. A common concern was "how can I be with a soul mate and still be my own person?" When you were true to your own needs, with an objective awareness about pleasing others, you managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? Lovers were stimulating forces. Partnerships helped fulfill a need to have a trusted confidante. It was impatience that often turned friends and lovers against you. Though when you showed a feisty directness that encouraged others to act, you were mostly a hit. When you compromised appropriately, this kept you on track as much as senseless fighting took you off target. Somewhere, always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks were very poised instincts mixed with a bit of hot red warlike impulsiveness. When using this wisely and coolly, life was colored with a knack for finding those individuals and choices that made you feel

exuberant.

Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression

Sun in Aquarius:

The sign of Aquarius, the water bearer, lighted the mid-winter astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Aquarius is "I know". You had a repeating pattern tied to gaining breakthrough knowledge. An experimental streak followed you from one incarnation to another.

Archetypes for Aquarius include the rebel, inventor and genius. You didn't fit conveniently into the roles assigned to you by others. Surprise excited you.

The cosmic principle at work through many of your past lives was beating to your own drum. You could dance to the tune created by someone else, but at the same time were anxious to tap out a few of your own. The intellect had the edge. This isn't saying you didn't have a heart. It's just that your first impulse was to think. When you allowed yourself to feel, a broader array of possibilities came your way in the form of people and even professions. You came into this life solarized through a sign promoting unique perceptions. This was a theme that ran throughout your lifetimes and was a key to self-mastery. Ingenuity was your coat of arms. You found ego strength through questioning the rules. Being different just to be different didn't work to your advantage. Your ideas made others wake up if they grew comfortably numb. There were occasions when you were so fond of the old ways that those bringing change were seen as troublemakers. Knowing when to fight for change, or to preserve something better, was a sign of wisdom. It was when you had a clear vision of the future through a lens of clearly defined goals that the present was a more stable and pleasurable landscape.

Sun in 9th house

You had solar power lifting your adventurous mind to explore alternative realities in previous lives. A restless drive to travel far from birth was a repeating pattern. Your creative vitality was insatiable when you were intent on making your ideals come true. Communication and education were favorite interests. You were a good debater and could argue a point until others became exhausted. Pride in your beliefs was a trait. You were admired for your relentless search for truth and a broad vision.

If there was a challenge it was becoming too dogmatic and judgmental. When you became too narrow in scope, people weren't as fond of you. When you maintained a more eclectic approach, you were a real hit. The student and teacher shined brightly through you. It was your capacity to motivate others out of their doldrums that won you accolades. Travel was one way you kept your mind entertained and growing. It took you longer than many to learn discipline. It's only that you didn't want to be tied down to commitments that kept you trapped. Your self-expression developed quickly when you finally found your piece of the pie. You liked having a sense of humor. You found fulfillment when seeing your ideas gaining acceptance, and being true to your philosophical beliefs.

Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings

Moon in Sagittarius:

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Sagittarius. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual urge to explore life from multiple directions followed you from one incarnation to another. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a love of the foreign, and a high-powered belief system.

Your inner landscapes were colored by a strong faith, which sustained you through the tough times. Many called it luck, but didn't see how much effort you put into the positive. Freedom was a word you understood early. You sought after knowledge because it kept you young in spirit and near the heartbeat of developing new trends. Travel made you feel in touch with creation and helped develop your creativity. Writing and all forms of communication were in your soul.

You frequently lived in various locations. The gypsy in you was restless for adventure. Concentration and discipline were challenges. Overconfidence got you to bite off more than you could chew. Promising too much did cause you to disappoint others occasionally. Dogmatism dulled your intellect. A sense of humor kept things in perspective. Moon in 11th house

Ascendant: Persona, Identity, Calling Card

Virgo on Ascendant:

People often saw you as reliable and trustworthy. A strong desire to be organized was part of your past life history. The business world was never far from you. The Quest

Mercury: Communication, Perceptions and Logic

Mercury in Aquarius

Mercury in 9th house

Mars: Assertion, Courage, Identity

What would a warrior planet in the watery sign of Scorpio mean regarding your past lives? When you were focused it was with the precision and intensity of a powerful laser beam. Although when you couldn't find the right outlets to express the passion you felt, it was like living in a pressure cooker sitting on top of a hot flame.

You were capable of creative explosions when the spirit moved you. The Journey

Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility

Saturn in Aries

Uranus: Individuality, Goals, Uniqueness, Freedom

You didn't normally consider the consequences of your actions. You weren't one to compromise your freedom, which incidentally was your lifeline. Neptune: Idealism, Romanticism, Intuition, Dreams, Escapism

Neptune in Scorpio

Neptune in 11th house

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to a sense of direction. You could feel out the way to go. The exception being if you became disillusioned with your world. You became mesmerized by unique thinking individuals. Especially those with a seductive presence,

speaking words that encouraged you to transcend ordinary time and place. Your idealism found you seeking unique ideals.

A test was not being with people doing a lot of taking, giving little in return. Your spirituality was usually unconventional, or at least you thought for yourself. What was the biggest challenge? It was when you felt like you were treading water and having no idea how to move forward. You did get fogged when your favorite dreams turned out to be mirages. This often happened after not really facing reality. Faith transformed your denial into an objective gaze at your possibilities. You searched for a purpose that pushed you to vigorously pursue your hopes.

Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion

Pluto in Virgo

Empowering yourself through using analytical ability was a past lives tendency. Perfection drove you on to try to do great things. Being reasonable in your expectations was wise. Extreme worry was sometimes a downfall. Curbing this tendency did make you happier and allowed for greater productivity. Charisma was exhibited through working forcefully at whatever you made your life mission. Escaping into projects made you less nervous. There was a habit of putting your heart and soul into a cause.

There was a shadow. What was it? Criticism. You could spot if something was out of place in a second. You did at times overly pick apart yourself or others. When you got this one under control, good fortune was never far away. Self-mastery was discovered through deciphering the ways to work smarter rather than harder. You found rebirth or a sense of fulfillment when overcoming negative thought patterns, and seeing that altered perceptions were truly miracles.

Pluto in 2nd house

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? That's an easy one to answer. You learned as much as you could about the economy you lived within. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through a tenacious resourcefulness. You didn't have much quit in you. Patience was the key. Careless spending did need a watchful eye upon it. A powerful self-examination manifested itself if you felt too hemmed in by your fixed thinking. A compulsive dive into various desires got you to ask thought-provoking questions. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations linked either to too great an attachment to material wealth, or overly identifying with a poverty consciousness. Finding the middle ground in this dilemma allowed a new revitalized you to be born. Giving and receiving required great awareness.

Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

Moon trine Saturn

You accepted responsibility without feeling infringed upon. When you didn't want your life weighed down by someone else's problems, you might run away. People found you easy going and letting life come to you. Some saw you as too relaxed. When you did find an ambitious streak, you were lucky in finding opportunities. You then only had to keep maintaining the effort.

Moon square Pluto

You had strong emotions that either helped you work through problems or got you overly attached to them. You lived like there was no tomorrow when you were moving fast along the

directions you enjoyed. Living with you meant dealing with your mood swings. People had to figure out when it was best to leave you alone. Though it helped if you gave a clue. You enjoyed privacy. Betrayals in partnerships and in love left serious wounds. It was the aftermath, how you dealt with these events that was crucial to your ongoing happiness. Power struggles occurred. Being harder on a problem than a person was wise.

Moon conjunct Midheaven

A well-defined intuition guided you to seek roles that gave you a deeper sense of meaning. Professions that intensified your emotions were what you chose. Having both a public presence and a carefully planned home life were important to you. You were sometimes a bit timid in letting the world know you had ability. It took support or a push from others to get you to come forward more visibly. You usually accepted responsibility that came your way. The major exception was if you became depleted of energy or depressed. You were sensitive about being seen as a success.

Moon square Ascendant

You were an emotional force in the lives of those you loved, sometimes more than they wanted. Stormy moods made clear thinking a real challenge. You either cared too much or were accused of ignoring those closest to you. Being as changeable as the moon's phases in one day is what upset a few individuals. A restless urgency to go where you wouldn't miss out on growth-opportunities is what caused to move often. Logic wasn't necessarily your main tool when in a stressful conflict. Toning down your response time did avoid a few embarrassing situations. Then again, it was occasionally the people you leaned on that were unpredictable, lacking stability. When you escaped from unstable circumstances you felt more in control as well as rooted, and lighter in worry.

Sun square Mars

You believed in the spirit of competition and were dynamic in expressing yourself. Patience wasn't your strong suit. People liked your zest for life as it motivated them to get moving. You didn't pay a lot of attention to limits. A me-focus caused tension if you carried it to the extreme. You got bored if there was no stress. Channeling your energy constructively was a prerequisite for your being successful in love and profession. Bickering with authority figures occurred when your territory seemed too invaded. You liked a lot of elbowroom when it came to making decisions. Discipline came when captivated by a subject of interest, and not a moment before. You experienced instant karma when not keeping your head when angry. When you avoided conflict altogether, it took the fire out of your enthusiasm.

Sun square Neptune

You depended heavily on the inspiration of your idealism. Romance and creative aspirations were the motivating forces, and in a big way! You experienced great conflict when those thinking you to be confused met your dreams with resistance. Emotions ran hot and cold. You

had more success when accepting life wasn't perfect, and it was okay that everyday living got a little messy. Your reality book wasn't the same one that everyone else used. This didn't strike you as true immediately. Eventually you started to see that there were certain paths you would take that few would understand. If you went too far out there, occasionally you lost your way. Changing the world to meet your specifications was a desire. You pushed your beliefs systems, at times too forcefully. You fell in and out of love with individuals and aspirations quickly. When you found the life directions that made your strongest statement, you tended to settle down. Escapism resulted only when the world seemed to be a disappointing place. Reality testing did help you get back to a warm place in the sun.

Mercury trine Jupiter

You had an even keel life philosophy, not wanting to let the unexpected blow you out of the water. It was possible to talk your way out of just about anything. You did sometimes deny reality because it seemed like too much trouble. A positive attitude brought you good luck more often than not.

Mercury trine Uranus

A vision for the future you naturally possessed. It was exhilarating to step out of the everyday routines. You liked variety. Disruptive people and sudden change were not that welcome. You liked new experiences that didn't make you extremely nervous. Travel and being exposed to different learning environments opened your eyes to exciting paths. You had a fondness for new trends as long as they didn't stamp out the past that you valued.

Mercury trine Ascendant

A mellow way of expressing your ideas put others at ease. You enjoyed talking about yourself. You had to develop your powers of concentration, which got a little easier when finding your favorite life interests. A change of routine was wise when attempting to energize your mind. You didn't like to worry, viewing it as a waste of time.

Venus oppose Jupiter

It was when traveling on the mental or physical levels with others that you became truly excited. You liked individuals with a sense of humor and who had the faith to act out their beliefs. Your closest friends and lovers shared much of your philosophy. There was sensitivity about people showing confidence in you. You occasionally were too idealistic when trusting others. Good fortune came through meeting the right individuals at the right time. Being generous toward those you loved made you popular. Values were of particular importance. People with integrity you tended to trust. You looked for a soul mate with a similar fascination with learning.

Venus oppose Uranus

People often perceived you as an interesting individualist. They either admired your freedom-thinking mind or feared it. Your romances were as exciting as unpredictable. You eventually found a need for stability as the roller coaster ride of love wore you down. Then again, when things grew too normal, you were rebelling. Inventive individuals fascinated you. Your friends and lovers usually had to be able to keep up with you mentally. Finding that delicate balance between calm and storm was the real challenge. You bored so easily when life was too predictable. But you could be a nervous wreck if it was always in question. You needed goals that matched what you needed for self-esteem. Your soul mates often shared your same sense of awe when it came to being experimental.

Venus conjunct Node

You searched for fulfillment through meeting the right people. It wasn't that you feared going it alone, it's that you thoroughly enjoyed the sharing. Your self-esteem had to stay high. This not only was connected to partnerships, but to finding meaningful occupations as well. You usually were a sensual person, in love with beauty in all of its forms. If there was a real test it was in being too easily talked out of your dreams. You then felt empty. The good news is that when you renewed your commitment to seek the fulfilling life you deserved, life was ready and willing to help you. Romance had a way of making you forget your troubles. Of course, it didn't hurt if you didn't forget to do a little reality testing now and then!

Mars conjunct Neptune

Marching forward with being motivated by ideals played a part in your past. You were a seeker of symbols that inspired a drive to rise above your problems. Emotional intensity was often strong. Causes drew you away from everyday norms to fight for a larger belief system. When you grew weary from the challenges of the world, you occasionally sought refuge. You were a romantic that needed to be careful when charging recklessly forward into love or toward ideals. If you were lost in escapism, you lost your sense of direction. You were at your best when not so disillusioned by life's ups and downs. Guilt caused you to feel too responsible for others. Anger was either blurted out instantaneously or hidden deep within your feelings. When being more direct, you acted with greater clarity for the most part.

Jupiter conjunct Uranus

Freedom. It meant everything to you! Your mind went off on a tangent, like an inventor, not able to stop the force of new ideas. A rebel that struck with great wit was you. There were those not fond of your ideas. You were not exactly the most stabilizing factor. You had a philosophy that woke up the minds of your contemporaries, sometimes infuriating them. It was when you threatened someone's comfort zones that you got the strongest reaction. You didn't always greet change warmly. Innovators had to prove their thinking was for the good or you resisted ruthlessly. Developing consistency and follow through was a challenge.

Jupiter oppose Node

If you are reading this one, many of your past lives had a pattern of anxiously finding something or someone to believe in. In the final analysis, it was your own self-confidence and self-understanding that was the key to your fulfillment. A tendency to go where the grass was greener did cause you to leave situations in favor of better opportunities. Twenty-twenty hindsight taught you that patience might have been wise. However, at times you smartly left behind very limiting circumstances. Being dogmatically attached to a narrow philosophy didn't open the door to many possibilities. Nor did being compulsively expansive help you get much accomplished. An open-minded perspective with a passionate longing to express your knowledge was a winning combination. The teacher and advisor in you became evident to others. When not running from your shadows, you became incredibly strong.

Jupiter conjunct Ascendant

An open mind allowed you to discover many ways to seek fulfillment. It was your positive outlook that brought good luck. Being tied down without any hope of freedom made you uneasy. Some perceived you to be unreliable and lacking focus. You saw this as a need to travel in search of more expansive growth. Staying away from narrow judgments made you more likeable and approachable.

Saturn trine Midheaven

Your sense of timing was better than most. You were not in the habit of forcing the outcome of situations. Ambition was expressed with an ease that in some respects hid your real intensity.

Uranus oppose Node

You knew that maintaining your freedom was your lifeline. If you became comfortably numb, no longer caring about your personal autonomy, something within you died. Then it took meeting a rebellious soul or having an experience awaken this side of you again. If you went to the extreme of only serving yourself, it was hard for anyone to get real close to you. There was an inventor and innovator pulsating lively inside, just waiting for the chances to be discovered. You didn't fit into traditional institutions unless making great adjustments. This isn't saying there were no instances when your gifts didn't benefit a mainstream society. You had trouble waiting for others to catch up to your thinking! A revolutionary spirit dominated your mind. Your gift was great vision. A shadow was lack of foresight when you moved with reckless abandonment. It took courage and insight to make this very special dimension of your consciousness work in your favor.

Uranus conjunct Ascendant

You weren't accused of being real predictable. Hoping that everyday was unique was more like what you wanted. Freedom was your greatest need. Equality was a sensitive issue. You had fast reflexes. A lack of forethought sometimes got you to make compulsive decisions. Keeping your mind occupied made you less nervous. Some perceived you to be a rebel. It was in knowing when and where to fight for change that you had the challenge. There were individuals finding

you eccentric and erratic. There were even lives when you fought against change, usually because it infringed on your beliefs, or you just plain didn't want to budge. Learning to compromise made for less friction. You were someone with electrifying ideas that stimulated others.

Neptune trine Node

Destiny had a way of sending you messages about which doors to knock on. You sensed the trails that led to fulfillment. Occasionally you took a detour to see if the scenery was different. You found what you were looking for by not doubting that life would bring the experiences that were needed to fulfill your dreams.

Pluto oppose Node

Defying the odds against you being successful was something you enjoyed taking on. You didn't use the best judgement necessarily in selecting partners. However, through trial and error, you got better at knowing who were your true friends and allies. Betrayals haunted you when investing in individuals that dealt off the bottom of the deck. When you found those right people, your partnerships were totally empowering. Lovers gave as much as they took when you made clear choices. Equal power was essential in your personal dealings. There was a tendency to process things long after they happened. The loss of someone close was never easy to handle. The reason being you bonded so deeply. Trust took you a lot of time ordinarily to establish. Facing your shadows kept them from ruling you. Rebirths were common, especially after dealing with a crisis.

Pluto square Midheaven

Life went better when you developed the insight to know which battles were worth fighting. Power struggles required your greatest wisdom to keep them from escalating. When you chose the path of self-illumination the magic of the universe smiled at you. When people became jealous of your success, it was best not to let this get under your skin. When making your talents known, becoming tough skinned was something you learned. A persevering spirit was what made you a success. Jealousy and manipulation were constant temptations. Reaching into their jars only sparingly was better than being consumed by these negative forces. You incarnated with great personal power. The trick was being able to direct this energy at growth-promoting targets.

Pluto conjunct Ascendant

It wasn't easy to figure you out as being secretive was in your nature. A quiet intensity was in your gaze and footsteps. You sometimes didn't forgive and held grudges for long time periods. It was easy to accuse you of being stubborn. Getting over the past was freeing. A type of rebirth periodically occurred when you discovered a deeper part of your identity. Empowerment came through making choices based on clear thinking rather than compulsive actions. Self-mastery came through facing your shadows.

Ascendant oppose Node

Subconscious impulses were powerful. You had to be careful in not letting irrational fears be your most dominant expression. Relationships, especially romantic or family ones, had a way of hitting a nerve. Trust didn't come easily if someone started to activate memories that reminded you of the past that went sour. You liked to be needed because it deepened your purpose. When trying to find too much of yourself in someone else was when you lost your balance. Keeping dependency needs clearly defined helped make life happier. Maintaining a sensible and objective framework from which to operate was a key ingredient to harmony.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.

Leo on 2nd house:

You preferred to know you had freedom of choice. Pride in what you owned was a common occurrence. Knowing you could have life on your own terms meant a lot to you. Flexibility was a challenge. When you showed willingness to compromise, life was smoother. You were more successful in partnerships when there were few strings attached. In other words there weren't hidden agendas. If there was something that led you astray, it was getting lost in physical desires. This was your way of coping with disappointment. Bigger meant better. Moderation was wise. Mixing pleasure and work was your best game plan. It was in your nature to want the best of both of these worlds.

3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.

Cancer on 3rd house:

You relied heavily on your intuition in perceiving the reality of situations. Your emotions sometimes fogged your seeing clearly. You did better when taking your time on the big decisions. A pattern of wanting to process before moving too rapidly was what you favored when possible to do so. Acting on impulse did occur when your feelings really got you to go for it. You were able to elicit strong emotional reactions from others through your ideas. People found you an unpredictable sort when your moods caused you to think spontaneously. If you manipulated by using the silent treatment it caused tension and confusion. You were sensitive about being critiqued. You released full creative power when you transcended a tendency to be too self-conscious.

4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.

Gemini on 4th house:

You had a restless nature to see what the world had to offer. Your creative mental power was

reinforced when living in locations that allowed you to more freely express yourself. An inability to get focused was your big challenge. Your sense of security often depended on the degree of your mental and physical freedom. Living in places where the people were open to new ideas, made you feel more at home. You kept your emotional distance until getting to really know someone.

5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.

Taurus on 5th house:

A tenacious creative spirit played a big part in your success. Romance inspired you to be creative. You tended to be somewhat possessive of others. Learning to let others express their thoughts freely proved wise. Inspiring confidence in those you cared about made them trust you. Drives to be powerful caused some conflicts. Your steady determination often made you a success. You were at your best when showing a tremendous physical and psychological endurance to endure life's challenges. Pride caused distance from those you loved. When you acted more from the heart than a false show of strength, people supported you.

6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.

Aries on 6th house:

A fast work pace colored past incarnations. Paying attention to details didn't coming easily. Everyday life seemed to move too slowly. Making up your mind fast when solving problems was a past pattern. You were usually impatient with obstacles. You often did better when being able to channel this fiery energy at projects rather than taking it out on others. When you did develop the powers of concentration you were capable of longer commitments to expressing your talents. You had a habit of reacting angrily to criticism. Also, it was important that you didn't jump to conclusions in analyzing others. When you overcame a lack of confidence, life became wonderful!

7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.

Pisces on 7th house:

Relationships were a panorama of splendor. They fascinated you! Defining your boundaries in partnerships was never easy. You did seek a soul mate intensely. Romantic encounters led to confusing circumstances. If you settled for vague definitions it got worse. When you didn't receive the love you sought, occasionally the emotional pain took you down self-defeating paths. What turned this tendency around? Your faith in self and a higher power was the usual remedy. Your partners ranged from individuals with vision to those with their eyes on escapism. You enjoyed great love when the two of you had similar values. Your expectations of people needed to adjust to a more reasonable level so that divine discontent didn't rule you. Sooner or later you began to see there was no perfect person. This often gave you the greatest clarity. When you put too much hope in others it didn't always yield the best results. When you carefully balanced your own needs with that of a lover or friend, life was more pleasant. Also, getting the giving and receiving in proper proportion was wise.

8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.

Aquarius on 8th house:

You needed to be your own person in relationships. You did better with lovers when you were self-reliant. If you or your partner leaned on the other too heavily, the harmony suffered the consequences. Power struggles with controlling people did occur. Those that were jealous of your free spirited ways could become adversaries. When you tried to get too bossy with independent individuals it often blew up in your face. A mutual respect for autonomy with a lover or friend made for more peaceful outcomes. Dealing with untimely losses did one of two things. It either stopped you dead in your tracks for long periods of time or propelled you forcefully ahead with great determination. A loss of direction felt like death. You found rebirth through discovering the paths that unleashed an unbridled passion for unique splendor.

9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.

Capricorn on 9th house:

A pragmatic philosophy governed much of your thinking. People with reasoning that lacked solid logic didn't usually capture your attention. This doesn't mean you had no idealism. Only that you responded better to those with sensible thinking. You had a sober belief system. Traditional rites and rituals were more readily accepted. Your commitment to ethics was strong. Staying positive in thought took you many more miles to your destinations than did self-doubt. Focusing excessively on what you lacked never did much for your mind. A healthy respect for failure combined with an optimistic flight pattern toward success, was a better path to go. You knew your limits, but were happier when not ruled by them. Taking carefully defined risks was what you liked.

10th House: Professions, ambition, leadership, focus, commitments.

Sagittarius on 10th house:

You never liked to feel confined in limiting roles. Your self-confidence kept your options open, and occasionally defeated great odds against you. Where did you have difficulty? When you couldn't get focused or disciplined. A lack of commitment came when you wanted to try more than one thing at a time. You didn't always get focused real fast. When you did find your true paths, a tireless energy to go to the top did emanate. You did arouse the wrath of others when thinking you had all of the answers. Tolerance took you further. You detested taking orders, especially from people you didn't respect. You had a way of getting people to believe in you. When you followed through on promises you made, you kept more friends. Learning to keep exaggeration of your talents to a minimum proved wise. A positive attitude brought you good luck.

11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.

Scorpio on 11th house:

A slow and persistent approach to reaching future goals was how you operated. You had to warm up to new directions. There was a preference to process circumstances first and then act later. Keeping your goals hidden from others gave you a sense of power. Your hopes vacillated

between waning and waxing almost as fast as the Moon changed phases. Sensing your moods was how you instinctually prepared to make changes. Fighting for your freedom was not uncommon. Though when you rebelled with no true purpose havoc was the result. When people tried to mold you into someone else, you did resist fervently. Individuals who betrayed you didn't stay on your guest list. It was in not seeking revenge you showed wisdom. Dealing with possessive acquaintances could be tiring. You broke free from manipulative types more than once. Indecisive individuals didn't impress you. Those people with an intensity to make things happen excited you.

12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.

Libra on 12th house:

You believed that love was worth taking the risk. Falling in love was a real high and stimulated your creative thinking. You didn't have much use for being alone. Seeking a soul mate was often a number one priority. You were at times attracted to people with escapist tendencies. They couldn't face reality. Your faith was tested when love failed. You found great strength when able to move ahead, with or without a partner. You were happier when finding balanced relationships where neither you nor your lover had to do most of the compromising. You usually had to adopt tougher skin so other people's opinions didn't hurt your feelings. Sensitive you were. But a doormat not always so! You did overly idealize others until reality struck. Indecision felt like a curse. Acting on what you believed to be true made you happier than compulsively thinking about the possibilities. When you reflected calmly while life was testing you, and listened to your intuitive voice for additional clarity, you were on top of your game!

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

Jupiter retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had a challenge in not foolishly believing in the wrong things or people. When you were on target and accurately assessing situations, you were a dynamo of efficiency and inspiration. Another challenge was in the area of confidence. When you lost faith it took the wind out of your sails. The search for an expansive enough vision was an innate drive. People didn't respond as well if you preached dogma or grew too judgmental. When you kept an open mind there was less friction. You had a capacity to embrace a positive outlook, that is, if self-doubt didn't seep into your thinking. Another challenge was running too fast to where the grass might be greener, running away from facing problems. The optimist in you needed to know limits. When you walked with commonsense and put your ideas into worthwhile actions, the world had no choice but to eventually give into your needs for self-discovery.

Uranus Retrograde:

It was a repeating pattern that you had unique goals, reserved just for you. When you didn't do this, life lacked meaning. When you solely served your own purposes this caused quite a ruffle in the feathers of those you loved and cared about. Finding the midstream worked the best regarding these two extremes of sacrifice and doing your own thing. Your ideas sent shock waves at times when individuals or collective bodies didn't like the message. You did sometimes tap into a collective trend before it became in vogue. It did make you nervous about how you might be judged. Many ideas were kept internalized until you were sure the coast was clear and safe enough to present the notions. Were you ever more outwardly disruptive? For sure! This usually occurred when you were so aroused by injustices or thinking restrictions imposed upon you. There was a need to perceive with fore thought, which fights were worth the struggle. Being different just to be different or starting conflicts with no purpose, were ways you took many steps in the wrong direction. Listening to cues from the universe on which directions promised accelerated growth was wise.
